EDUCATION TRENDS IN THE PANDEMIC AND BEYOND

A RECENT POLL BY MORNING CONSULT AND ED-CHOICE REVEALS SOME CONCERNING TRENDS IN PARENTS' OPINIONS ON K-12 EDUCATION. FOR ONE THING, PARENTS ARE NOT COMFORTABLE WITH CHILDREN RETURNING TO IN-PERSON CLASSES. ABOUT TWO-THIRDS THOUGHT SCHOOLS WON'T BE SAFE UNTIL WELL INTO 2021. ON THE OTHER HAND, PARENTS AREN'T ENTHUSIASTIC ABOUT HOME-SCHOOLING, EITHER. MOST WANT SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION FOR REMOTE LEARNING.
